# **General Information**


Refer to quilt photo for fabric placement.


Note: If you are using a different fabric swatch then the one displayed in the picture we would recommend using the numbers as references for which fabric pieces you need to use next.


All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise indicated. Always sew fabrics right sides together.


Finished Quilt Size - 54" x 66" Finished Block Sizes - 6" x 6"

- Fabric 1 1 2/3 Yards (This needs to be a solid or nondirectional fabric)
- Fabric 2 1 Yard
- Fabric 3 2/3 Yards
- Fabric 4 2/3 Yards
- Fabric 5 1/3 Yards
- Fabric 6 1/3 Yards
- Fabric 7 1/3 Yards
- Fabric 8 1/3 Yards
- Fabric 9 1/3 Yards
- Fabric 10 1/3 Yards
- Binding Fabric 3/4 Yards










# **Sewing Directions**

#### BLOCK A

 Lay out two 3.5" x 3.5" squares of Fabric 1 with two 3.5" x 3.5" squares of Fabric 3 as shown.




Take the two squares in the top sew and sew them together in the order presented. Press seam toward Fabric 3.



Take the two squares in the bottom row and sew them together in the order presented. Press seam toward Fabric 3.



4. Sew the top row and bottom row together. Press seam to the top.



5. Repeat steps 1-4 until you have a total of 25 Block A's.

# BLOCK B

Lay out two 3.5" x 3.5" squares of Fabric 1 with two 3.5" x 3.5" squares of Fabric 4 as shown.




Take the two squares in the top sew and sew them together in the order presented. Press seam toward Fabric 4.



Take the two squares in the bottom row and sew them together in the order presented. Press seam toward Fabric 4.



9. Sew the top row and bottom row together. Press seam to the top.



10. Repeat steps 6-9 until you have a total of 25 Block B's.

### ROW 1

 Lay out three Block A's, two Block B's, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 10, 2, 6, and 7 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press the seams to the left.



#### ROW 2

 Lay out two block A's, two Block B's, two 9.5" squares of Fabric 2, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 8, 9, and 5 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the right.



# ROW 3

 Lay out two Block A's, three block B's, two 9.5" squares of Fabric 2, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 7 and 10 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the left.



#### ROW 4

 Lay out two Block A's, two block B's, two 9.5" squares of Fabric 2, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 5, 8, and 9 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the right.



#### ROW 5

 Lay out three Block A's, two Block B's, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 6, 9, 2, and 5 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the right.



#### ROW 6

21. Lay out two Block A's, two Block B's, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 7, 10, 2, 6, and 8 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the right.



#### ROW 7

 Lay out two Block A's, three Block B's, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 5, 2, 8, and 9 as shown.



24. Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the left.



#### ROW 8

 Lay out two Block A's, two Block B's, two 9.5" squares of Fabric 2, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 6, 7, and 10 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the right.




#### ROW 9

 Lay out three Block A's, two Block B's, two 9.5" squares of Fabric 2, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 8, 9, and 6 as shown.



28. Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the left.



# **ROW 10**

29. Lay out two Block A's, two Block B's, two 9.5" squares of Fabric 2, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 8, 9, and 6 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the right.



# **ROW 11**

 Lay out two Block A's, three Block B's, and one 9.5" square of Fabrics 7, 6, 2, and 8 as shown.



Sew them together in the order presented. Press seams to the right.




# FINISHING THE QUILT


 Sew the top of row 2 onto the bottom of row 1. Press seam toward row 1.




34. Sew the top of row 3 onto the bottom of row 2. Press seam toward row 2.




35. Sew the top of row 4 onto the bottom of row 3. Press seam toward row 3.




36. Sew the top of row 5 onto the bottom of row 4. Press seam toward row 4.




 Sew the top of row 6 onto the bottom of row 5. Press seam toward row 5.




38. Sew the top of row 7 onto the bottom of row 6. Press seam toward row 6.




39. Sew the top of row 8 onto the bottom of row 7. Press seam toward row 7.




40. Sew the top of row 9 onto the bottom of row 8. Press seam toward row 8.



41. Sew the top of row 10 onto the bottom of row 8. Press seam toward row 8.



 Sew the top of row 11 onto the bottom of row 10. Press seam toward row 10.
