

All characters are measured from the lowest possible point to the highest. In Locker Talk[™], all black (non shift) characters and all gray (shifted) characters are created at the same height. The Layers on the first creative feature key are sized proportionately to fit the Base characters. If Real Dial Size is selected, all characters will be cut according to the selected dial size.




What Are Creative Feature Keys?

The top three pairs of keys on the left panel are reserved for the Creative Feature effects of each set. These Features vary with each specific cartridge, providing greater versatility and thousands of options!

The Creative Feature keys included on the Locker Talk™ cartridge are Layers, Phrase/Layers, Card, Book Cover, Shadow, and Blackout.


To use a Creative Feature key, just select it prior to pressing the CUT button. The characters displayed on the screen will then be cut in the style of the selected Creative Feature. Due to their sizes and shapes, a Feature may not work with all shapes. Please refer to the Icon Gallery for Creative Feature details.




TIP. A Feature can be selected before or after a character has been selected, but before the CUT button is pressed. Once pressed, a Feature key will remain lit until it is turned off in one of the following ways: the Feature key is pressed a second time or the Reset All key is pressed.

What is a Foundation Key?

Your Locker Talk[™] cartridge contains three Foundation keys with two characters on each key. Foundation shapes are the solid version of images that were used as Creative Features, or proportional images that Creative Feature keys can be used with. These proportional images are Foundation/Companion shapes. Foundation shapes and Foundation/Companion shapes can be used alone or as layers using the Creative Feature keys. They can also be enhanced by adding shapes or phrases to them.





Now you're ready to try a project!



Book Cover Card

Celebrate the first day of school in style! Use the book cover foundation key to create this colorfully fun card.

Materials: Cardstock; red, yellow, green, blue, black, tan Patterned paper: coordinating colors Ribbon: 5/8" Adhesive Paper trimmer



Step One: Create message for front of card. Using black cardstock, press Shift and cut one 3" <1stday>.

Step Two: Using tan cardstock, press Shift and Layers feature and cut one 3" <1stday>. Repeat with red and green cardstocks.



Step Three: Using blue cardstock, press Shift and Blackout feature and cut one 3" <1 stday>. Assemble layers.

Step Four: Create card from yellow cardstock using two book covers. Using yellow cardstock, press Shift and Blackout feature and cut two 4" <bkcover>.



Step Five: Position both book covers so that holes are on left side. Trim 1.5" off right side of one yellow book cover. Attach strip of patterned paper to second book cover along right edge. Lay trimmed book cover on top of large one, align holes, and tie together with ribbon. Adhere "first day of school" message to front of card extending off right edge so that it appears to overlap patterned paper.

In the Icon Gallery, you will find a diagram for every character on your cartridge. The color change indicates that the image on the upper right is created using the Shift key and the image on the lower left is created without Shift. Using the Icon Gallery, you can see at a glance which Creative Features are available to use with the character that you have selected. You will find that some characters are very detailed and cut better at a larger dial size.
