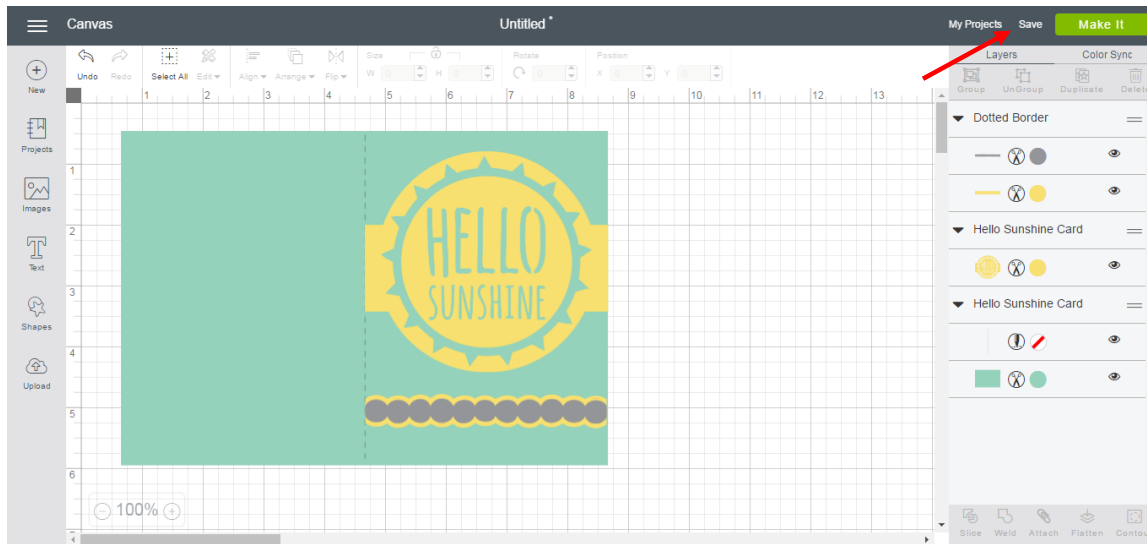

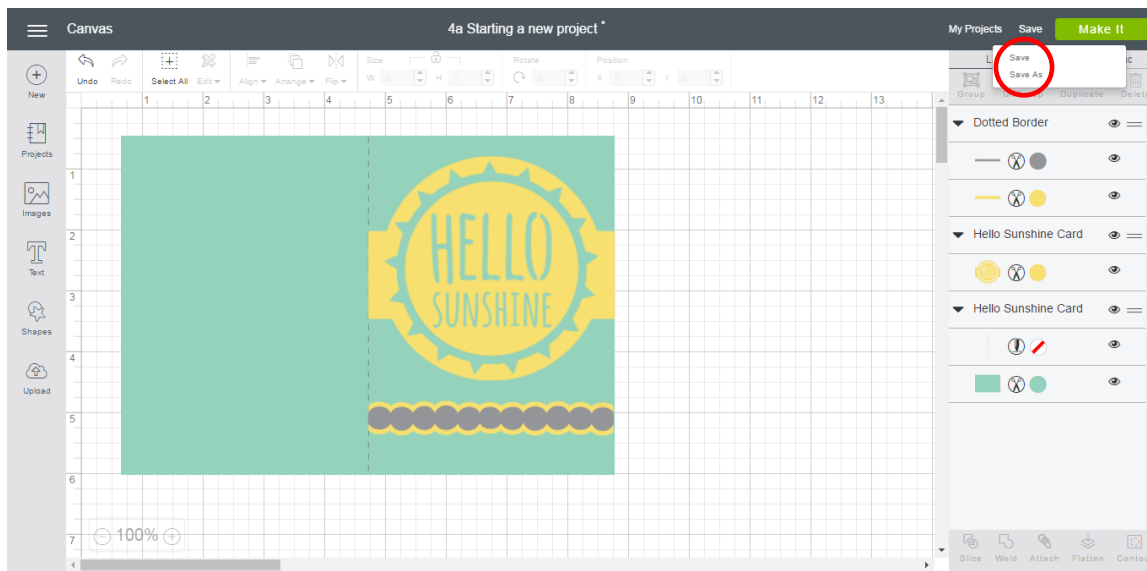
B. Saving a project

Once you've started a new project (your own or one predesigned in Design Space), you can save it at any time to the Cricut cloud, where it can be accessed from multiple devices.

Step 1 Click *Save* from the Canvas to create a project file.



If you have already saved the project, you will get the option to *Save* or *Save As*.

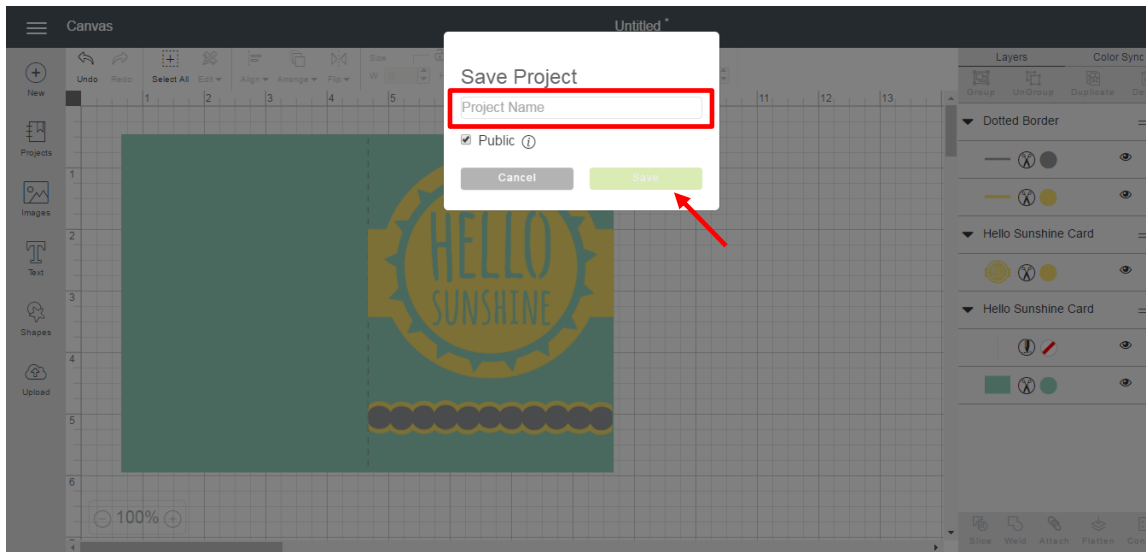


Save – Replaces the original project file with updated information.

Save As – Makes a copy of the project file. You'll be prompted to choose a new name for this copy.

Tip: Use Save As when you want to keep the original version of the project while creating a new version.

Step 2 The Save Project screen will open. Enter a name for your project, then click *Save*.



Step 3 After saving, you will return to the design screen. A message will say the project saved successfully. You will also see the project name at the top of the screen. You can continue designing your projects or click *Make It* to begin the cutting process.
