

Layers Panel Cheat Sheet

12 Design Space features and what they do.



Slice



Cuts one shape from another shape or deletes part of an image.



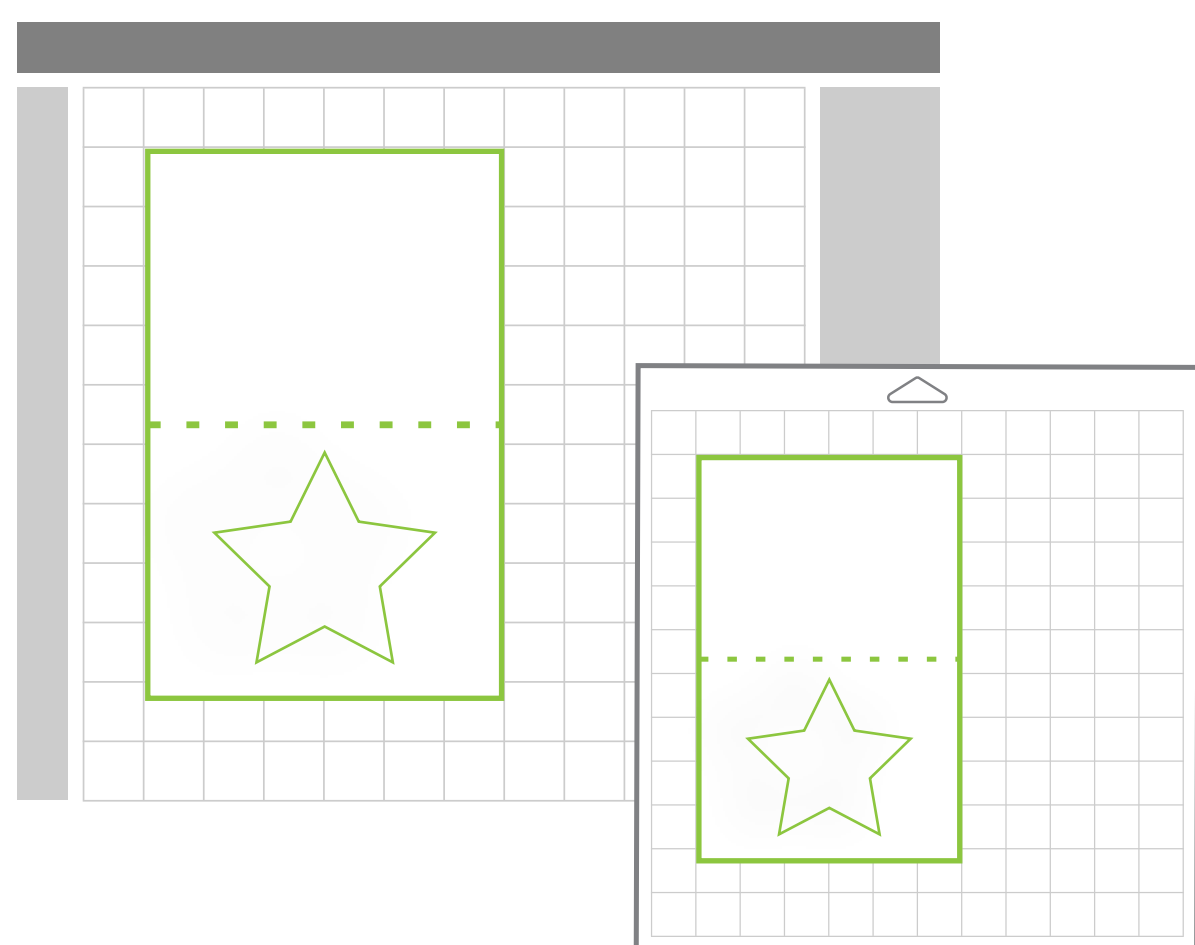
Weld



Removes overlapping cut lines by joining multiple layers.



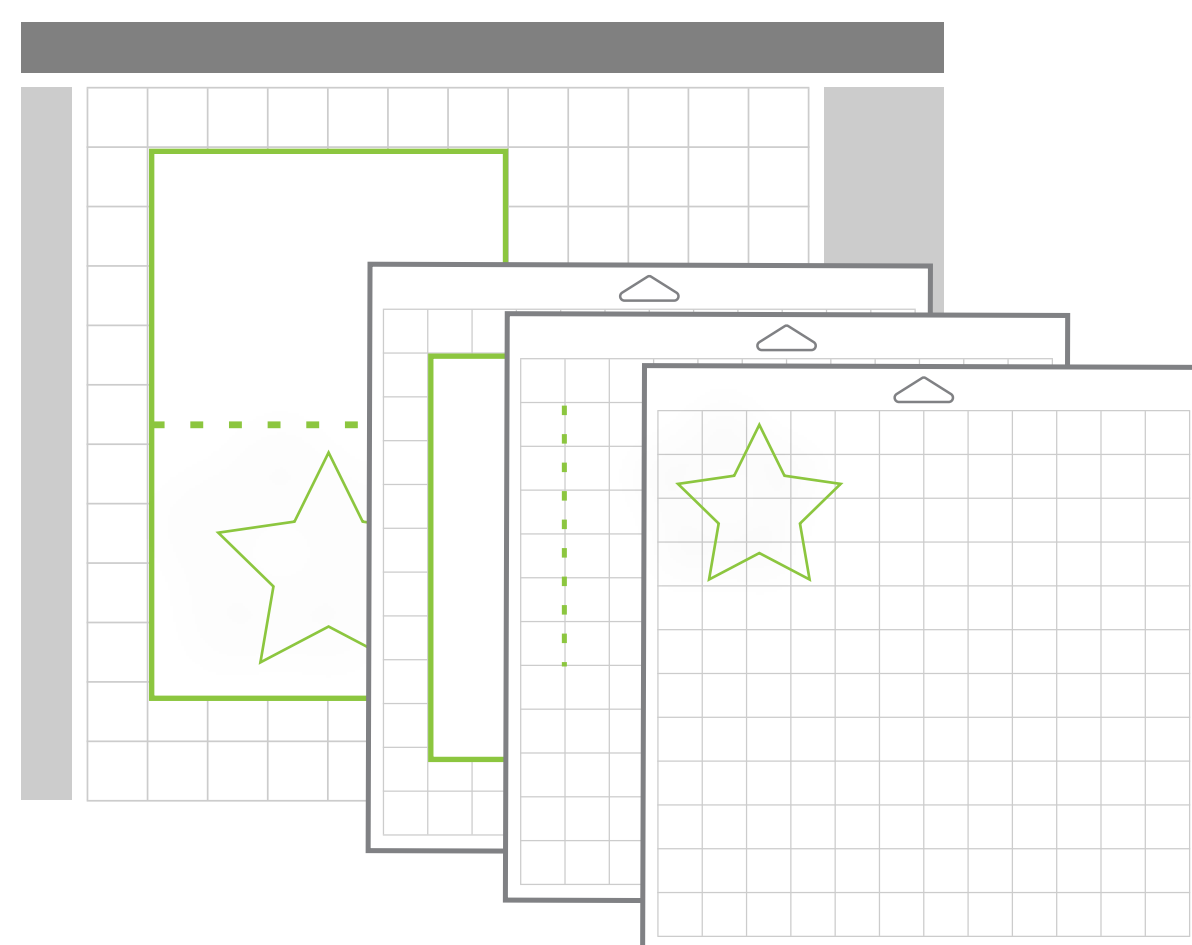
Attach



1. Holds shapes to the Canvas so they show up in the same place on the Prepare screen.
2. Attaches layers as well as score, draw, and cut lines so that they stay together when moved on Canvas. They also stay together on the Prepare screen.

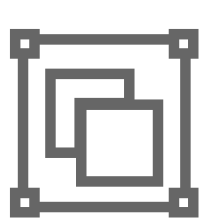


Detach



Separates objects into separate layers so you can create Cut, Draw, or Score lines independently.

To move or delete an object from your project, use Detach. Just remember to re-attach.

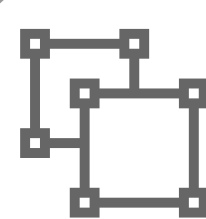


Group



Groups objects together so they move and re-size together on the Canvas.

Group, however, does not attach objects to each other on the mat.

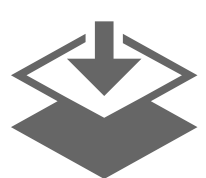


Ungroup



Separates layers so they move and size independently on your Canvas.

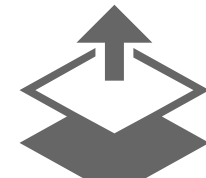
You can also Ungroup text to move letters individually.



Flatten



Combines many layers into one Print Then Cut layer.



Unflatten



Separates a single Print Then Cut layer into several individual Print Then Cut layers.



Contour



Hides or unhides individual contour lines or cut lines.

If the image is multilayered, you must ungroup it first.



Visible/hidden



Reveals or hides a layer. Hidden layers will not print, cut, write, or score.



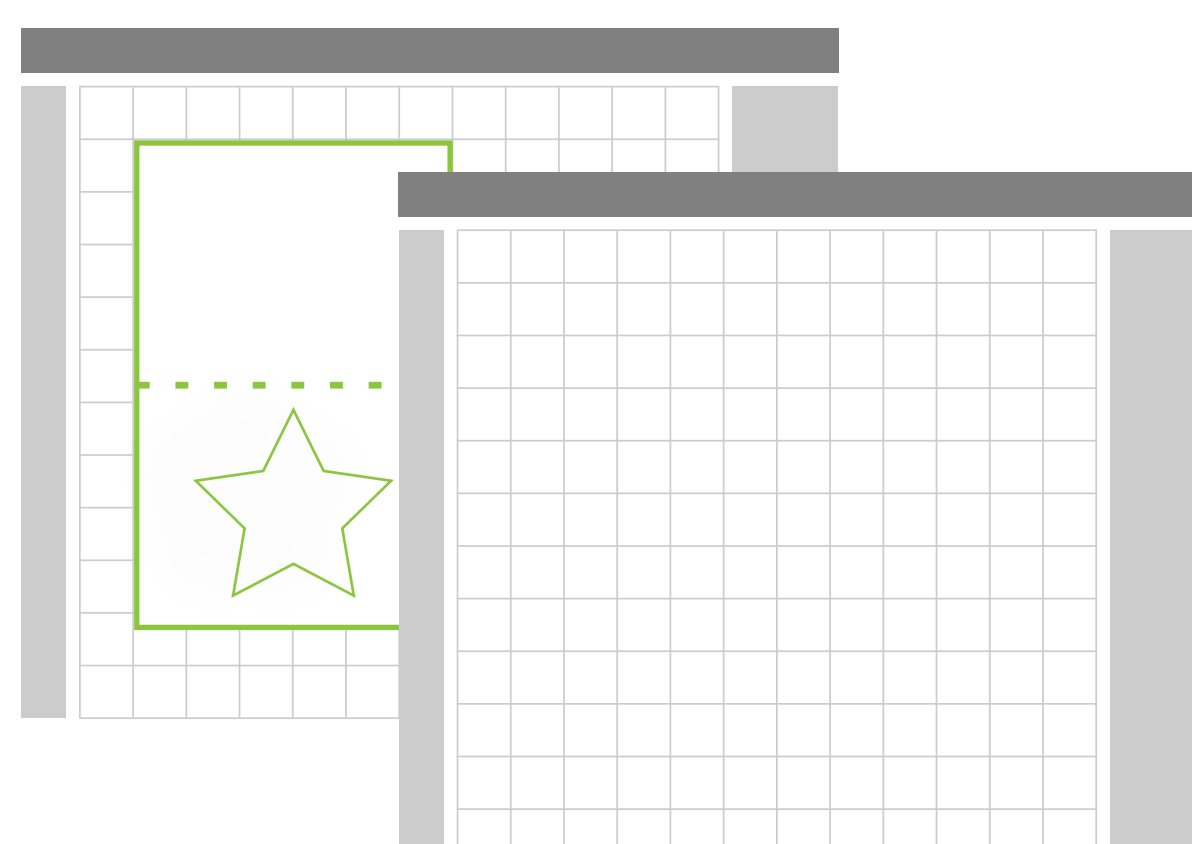
Duplicate



Creates duplicates of selected image.



Delete



Removes selected image from your Canvas.
