# Work With Zipped Folders in Design Space (iOS)?

Zipped files cannot be uploaded to Design Space. If you have an SVG saved inside of a zipped folder, you will need to remove it from the zipped folder prior to uploading it into Design Space.

#### iOS 11 devices:

1. Open the Files app on your device, and select the file storage application where you saved the zipped folder.

2. Locate the zipped folder and select it.

4. Swipe to locate the SVG image within the zipped folder.



5. Use the Share icon to move the image to a location outside of the zipped folder.



6. Return to Design Space and tap *Upload*, then *Browse files*.



7. Select the location where SVG file was saved outside of the zipped folder, then tap on the image to select it and upload it into Design Space.

#### iOS 9 & 10 devices:

iOS 9 & 10 do not have the Files app. You will need to unzip the folder so that the SVG files are ready to upload into Design Space. You can accomplish this using a variety of free unzipping utility apps available in the App Store.
